

Road Restrictions

Protecting the Roads to Ensure Safe Driving

Spring Load Restrictions will soon be in place. You can check your Fillmore County road weight limits by going to the Fillmore County web site at <http://www.co.fillmore.mn.us/highway/209-highway-maintenance>.

For Minnesota, Spring Load Restrictions (SLR) impact many more miles of the county, township and municipal systems than the state trunk highway system. Damage incurred to the entire road system is quite substantial if the restrictions are not placed before the critical thaw period.

It is important to remember that all county, township and municipal roads that have asphalt, concrete or aggregate-surface are restricted during SLR unless posted otherwise.

Once posted, the road restriction signs carry the full force of the law and compliance is required. These postings will be removed as conditions dictate. Questions concerning any County road should be directed to the Fillmore County Highway Department at 507-765-3854.
