

WHAT TO RECYCLE

PAPER

Newspaper—Cardboard—Box Board—Tag Board—Newspaper—Magazines—Catalogs
Junk Mail—Phone Books—Hard Cover Books—Paperbacks—Computer Paper
Paper Towel Tubes—Shredded Paper in a Closed Box or Closed Paper Bag

GLASS

Jars—Bottles—Jugs

STEEL/TIN & ALUMINUM CANS

Steel Covers—Clean Aluminum Foil and Pie Plates

PLASTICS

Bottles—Jugs—Ice Cream Pails

Any Plastic Container With a 1 or 2 Inside the “Chasing Arrows” on the Bottom
Take your plastic shopping bags and grocery bags back to a store.

WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE—PUT INTO HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Candy Wrappers—Used Tissue—Dirty Diapers—Small Appliances
Ovenware—Yogurt Containers—Fridge Packs—Plastic Toys—Flower Pots
Plastic Sleds—Canning Jars—Windows—Mirrors—Ceramics—Pottery—Light Bulbs
Egg Cartons—All Forms of Styrofoam—Soiled Cardboard Pizza Boxes—Waterbeds
Aluminum Foil with Food—Amber Pill Bottles—Lawn/Deck Furniture—Lumber

FILLMORE COUNTY ALSO ACCEPTS

Tires—Rims—Appliances—TVs—Computer—Fluorescent & High Intensity Discharge Lamps
CFLs—Oil Filters—Ballasts-- and E-waste for a fee

Batteries—Metal—Clothing—Curtains—Bedding—Shoes—Belts—Purses, and Waste Oil
are accepted at no charge.

CITY RESIDENTIAL & BUSINESS RECYCLING COLLECTION

Schedules will vary. Contact your hauler or city hall for your schedule.

RURAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Fillmore County rural residents may contract with a waste hauler for home service or use one of the County Recycling Containers or the Resource Recovery Center.

LOCATIONS OF COUNTY RECYCLING DROP-OFFS

1. Resource Recovery Center, Preston
Open Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m.—3:30 p.m.
and the first Saturday each month, 8:00 a.m.—12 noon.
2. Amherst Recycling Container, open 24 hours, every day.
3. Canton Recycling Container, open 24 hours, every day.
4. Chatfield Recycling Container, open 24 hours every day.
5. Cherry Grove Recycling Container, open 24 hours every day.
6. Peterson Recycling Container, open 24 hours every day.
7. Spring Valley Recycling Container, open 24 hours every day.

***THE RURAL RECYCLING CONTAINERS ARE NOT
TO BE USED FOR LANDFILL GARBAGE.***

HOW TO USE RURAL RECYCLING CONTAINERS

Transport to your nearest drop-off location and deposit into marked recycling container. *Do not place plastic bags into recycling containers.* Fiber recyclables may be placed into brown paper bags. Rigid recyclables must be deposited unbagged into the marked container. Fibers and Rigids may now be comingled in the same container.
